

PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

The goals of homework presentations are

- to emphasize individual mathematics efforts
- to evaluate student understanding of the material
- to develop the ability to communicate mathematical ideas

Presentations are to be made on the assigned date. Postponements will not be accepted except for emergencies or illness.

You may work with other students to develop the solution, but you must present the solution. Presentations cannot be copied from others' work.

You should use Power Point, MS Word, or some other electronic medium whenever possible to facilitate presentation and to make it easier for others to access your solutions. You should post your corrected solutions or else email them to me.

These presentations individually count 25 points each; together they will count as one exam grade.

You will have ten minutes for most presentations. You are expected to use at least five minutes, but not more than fifteen minutes.
