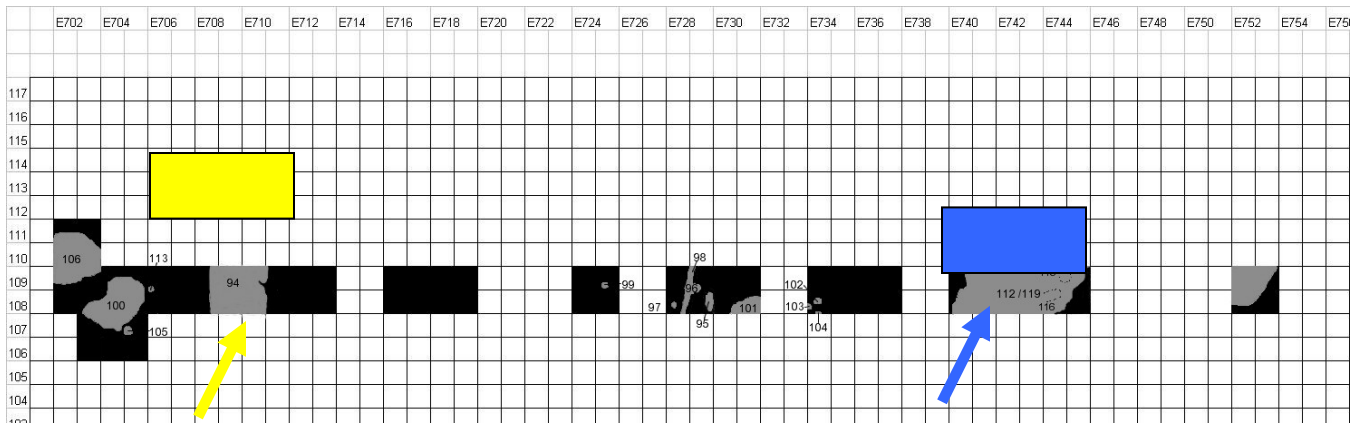


## RESULTS FROM JUNE 8, 2011

We were on-site and working before 8:00 this morning – already in the 70s with a promise of mid-upper 90s to come. By 9:30, two of our teams were at work expanding our 2008 excavations. The map of our 2008 excavations below illustrates the ditch-like feature (Feature 94 at left; yellow) that may be part of the palisade. The yellow shaded box shows our new excavation units. The blue arrow at right points to Feature 112/119, the possible pit structure – with the blue shaded box illustrating our expansion of those units.



Below in a view looking south, the crews on the right are searching for evidence of the palisade and the crews on the left are expanding the excavations over Feature 112/119, the possible pit structure.



While these crews continued work, Emily and I used our total station to shoot in new points on Mound 3 so that our other team could begin laying out their units and stripping the sod. By 9:30, they were ready to begin...



As the temperature reached into the mid-90s (in the shade somewhere at a weather station), we retreated to the shade for some labwork in the afternoon.
