Middle Tennessee State University will be hosting the Middle Tennessee Psychological Association's 2018 spring meeting on Saturday April 21, 2018. All events will take place in the College of Education Building on MTSU's campus in Murfreesboro, TN. The meeting provides an excellent opportunity for undergraduate and graduate students to present their efforts to colleagues from other colleges and universities.

Guidelines and Information

- The advance registration deadline is April 13, 2018. Please register by April 13; this will help us with an accurate count for refreshments. All attendees (including presenters) are required to register for the meeting.
- The registration fee is \$5.00 for students and community members and \$15.00 for faculty/professionals. High school students may attend for free, but still need to register. Registration includes membership in MTPA, a program, access to the conference, and breakfast.
- The submission deadline is April 13, 2018. All submissions received by the deadline will be accepted for presentation. Presenters will be notified by email that their submission has been received. A final program will be available online by April 17, 2018.
- The research should have been conducted by an undergraduate or graduate student. If a faculty member is a co-author, the student should be first author. The student researcher will be expected to make the presentation.
- Papers on completed research, ongoing research, or theoretical reviews are encouraged.
- Presenters may choose to make an oral presentation or to present a poster describing their research.
