- a. Define nuisance, based on the statutory and/or case law cited. In this case, what constituted the trespass?
- b. Define trespass, based on the statutory and/or case law cited. In this case, what constituted the nuisance?
- c. Analyze and explain how waste and water runoff from one property owner's property onto another's can be both nuisance and trespass.
- d. What is the "Right to Farm Act" and what does it do?
- e. Based on the arguments presented in the trial brief, analyze and explain why the "Right to Farm Act" may violate constitutional guarantees that no citizen will have his property taken without due process. (See Chapter 5 for a review of the due process clause.)
- f. In your opinion, why would the State of Tennessee have a law on its books that protects farmers from nuisance suits? Is there value in protecting farmers at the expenses of non-farmers? Why or why not? If you were creating public policy in this regard, what would your policy be?

- e. What are the challenges in determining property owners' rights when their property exists only in cyberspace?
